Dorothy Ann Fevold, 86, formerly of Badger, Iowa, passed away on September 18, 2019, at her home in San Diego, California. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, October 19, 2019 at 10:00 AM at the Badger Lutheran Church in Badger with Rev. Scott Meier officiating. Burial will be in the Blossom Hill Cemetery rural Badger.

Dorothy was born on December 7, 1932, at her parent's home in Badger. She attended a two-room schoolhouse in Badger all eight grades, then high school in Fort Dodge. She continued her education at the University of Northern Iowa, graduating in 1953. Her first teaching position was in Humboldt, Iowa. After teaching there for two years, Dorothy attended Luther College in Decorah, Iowa, earning her BA, graduating in 1956. Looking for adventure, she and her sister Marilyn, flew to Europe, Dorothy teaching at Mannheim Military Base in Germany, and Marilyn in France. Returning to the United States she enjoyed teaching in San Diego, CA, returning in 1991 after 37 years. Dorothy enjoyed traveling with her friends. Norway was her favorite. She worked part-time at the Seaport Scandinavian Store, volunteered at Christ Lutheran Church. She crocheted baby blankets and caps for newborns in the hospitals and knit scarves and hats for the homeless.

Dorothy is survived by her brother Lawrence Richard (Shirley), nieces Jane Fevold Stewart and Annie Fevold Simpson, nephews Alan, Jon and Brian Fevold. And many great-nieces and nephews. Preceding her in death were her parents Lawrence and Grace Fevold and her sister Marilyn Beth Fevold.
